Moderator Responsibilities

A moderator is the leader that takes charge and responsibility for the panel that they organize, and is the main speaker in a seminar. The moderator is the person who applied for the seminar. There can only be one moderator per seminar.

The moderator is responsible for:

- Communicating with TOTC on your panelist names, emails, and any updates to your seminar for the creation of the seminar media kit
- Coordinating with your presenters on seminar content, availability, and seminar logistics
- Submitting your flight stipend as a moderator to the TOTC Education Team
- Connecting with your CAP representative regarding any serves during your seminar
- Coordinating the presentation and keeping the seminar on time

Moderator Benefits

As a non-local moderator at Tales of the Cocktail 2024, you are eligible to receive the following:

- Presenter Wristband: All-Access Week-Long Seminar & Tasting Room Pass
- Two-night stay at one of the TOTC host hotels
 - Deadline to book: May 15th, 2024 you must use the booking link provided
 - TOTCF will underwrite an additional night for each additional seminar that a presenter (moderator or panelist) participates in for up to a maximum of four nights
- Eligible for Moderator Honorarium of \$150 per seminar moderated (max of 3 seminars)
 - Deadline to claim honorarium: August 25, 2024
- Flight stipend reimbursement
 - \$350 USD US Eastern States
 - \$450 USD US Western States
 - \$750 USD Outside of the United States
- Timeline to submit flight receipts: June 1-30, 2024
- Deadline to submit flight receipts: June 30, 2024

Panelist Responsibilities

A panelist is a person that is asked to speak on a seminar, is a contributor on the topic, and is not the original applicant or the point of contact for TOTC. If you were invited to join a seminar, YOU are a panelist.

- One night stay at a TOTC host hotel
 - Deadline to book: May 15th, 2024: you must use the booking link provided
 - TOTCF will underwrite an additional night for each additional seminar that a presenter (moderator or panelist) participates in for up to a maximum of four nights
- Eligible for Panelist Honorarium of \$75 per seminar, max of 3 seminars
- Deadline to book hotel room: May 15, 2024

Benefits

As a local (Greater New Orleans area) moderator or panelist for Tales of the Cocktail 2024, you are eligible to receive the following benefits:

- Presenter Wristband: All-Access Week-Long Seminar & Tasting Room Pass
- Moderator & Panelist: Up to \$50 a day for the day of the seminar in travel reimbursements (cab, Uber, Lyft, parking, etc.)
